State Legislation governing after school programs for middle schools funded by After School Education and Safety Program and/or 21st Century Community Learning Centers mandates that such programs must operate from the close of school every school day until 6:00 p.m. Programs in schools that dismiss students after 3:00 p.m. must operate a minimum of 3 hours per day. It is the intent of the State Legislation that middle school students attend a minimum of 3 days per week and participate in a minimum of 9 hours of program activities.
